

## Court Officials Create Institute On Ethics

The Administrative Board of the courts has established the Judicial Institute on Professionalism in the Law. The Institute will serve as a continuing forum for discussion of ethics and professionalism among lawyers. One of its purposes is to enhance public understanding and confidence in the profession.

Louis A. Craco of Wilkie, Farr & Gallagher will serve as Chairman of the Institute. The institute has seventeen other members including judges, members of law firms, a law school dean, two solo practitioners and a member of the public.

The institute will hold hearings into the public perception of lawyers. It will study the impact of law schools, law students, bar associations and the courts.
